Trees not Towers

In a Nutshell:

Eversource energy wants to build an 8.9 mile long, 115 thousand volt, 82 foot wide, 70-100 foot high, line of high tension power lines from Central Sudbury to Hudson Light and Power in Hudson, MA. This line crosses and would forever change the Assabet Valley Wildlife Refuge, and Marlboro State Forest, not to mention the hundreds of small business and abutting residential properties.

Facts:

- The Town of Sudbury opposes this project
- A completed rail trail is **not** a part of this project
- The underground alternative is likely to cause more environmental damage than the proposed alternative.
- The Town of Sudbury receives no benefits from the proposed power line.
- There is a viable alternative that does not involve placing a power line between Sudbury and Hudson.
- The proposed 82 foot wide clear-cut requires ongoing herbicide applications to maintain (kill)

growth in and around the poles. Some of these chemicals are proven toxic to wild life and human life.
